

Aloha, Friend!

Provide opportunities for children to greet or say goodbye to each other across the day, such as when working in a small group, during morning meeting, or as they sit together for a meal.

Example of greetings/goodbyes:

- Handshake
- High Five
- ♦ Fist Bump
- ♦ Hug
- Do-Si-Do
- ♦ Whisper Hello
- Wink
- Roll a ball across the circle to a friend
- Children invent a greeting

- ♦ Elbow tap
- Greet in another language
- Greet with a compliment
- Say hello in a low, deep voice
- Say hello in a high, squeaky voice
- Come up with and use a secret handshake



Topic Talk

Encourage children to engage in conversations based on a particular topic. You can draw topics out of a jar, or select based on current interests of your students.

Example topics:

- Going to the zoo
- Riding a bus
- Nature walks
- Pets
- Insects
- Seasons
- Brothers and sisters
- The beach

Encourage Talk That Goes Beyond the Here and Now

"If you have ever been on a bus before, tell us what you noticed when you rode it."

"Let's imagine spending a day at the beach in the summer. How do you imagine the sand feels on your feet?"
